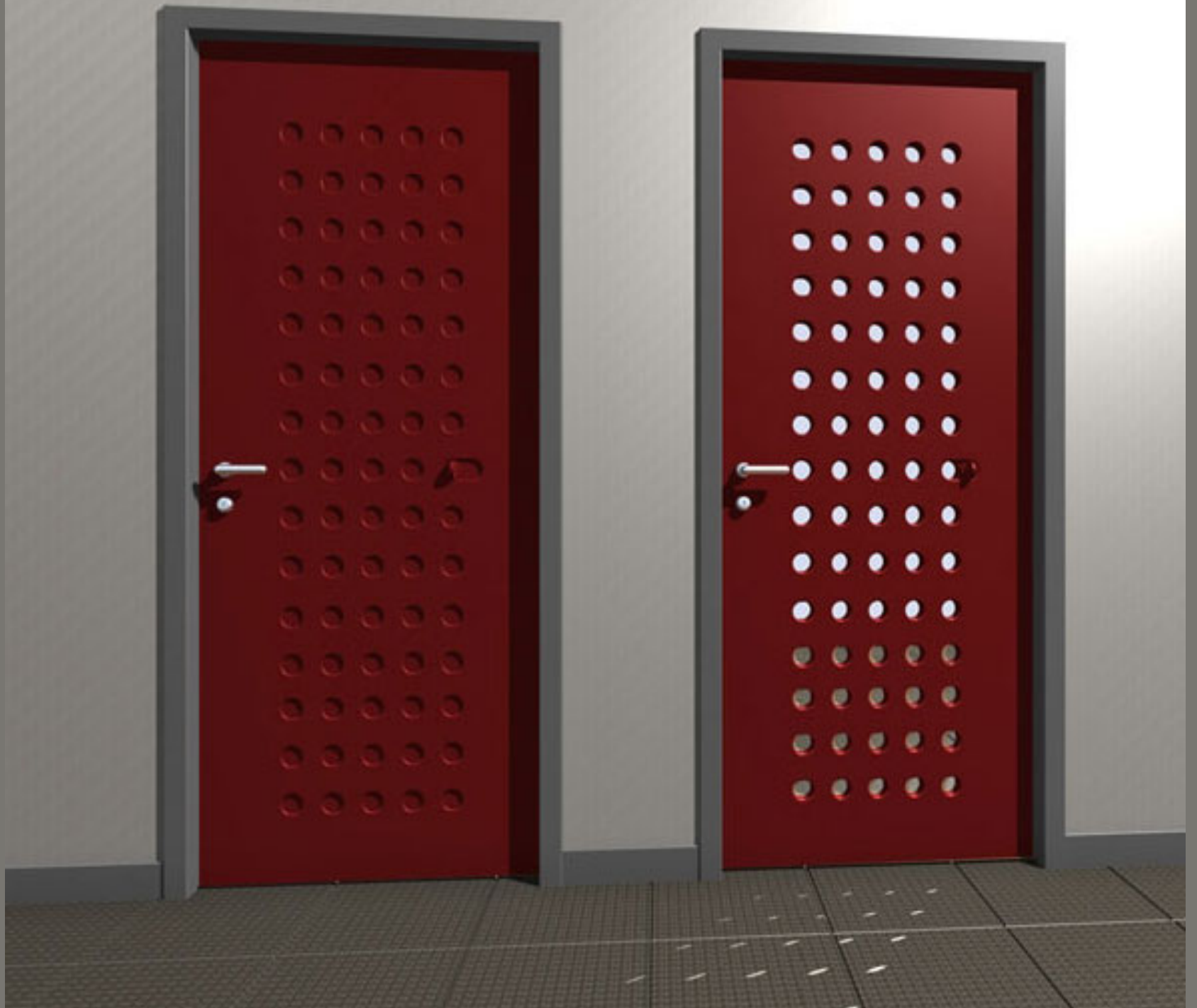




William Carey's birthplace
