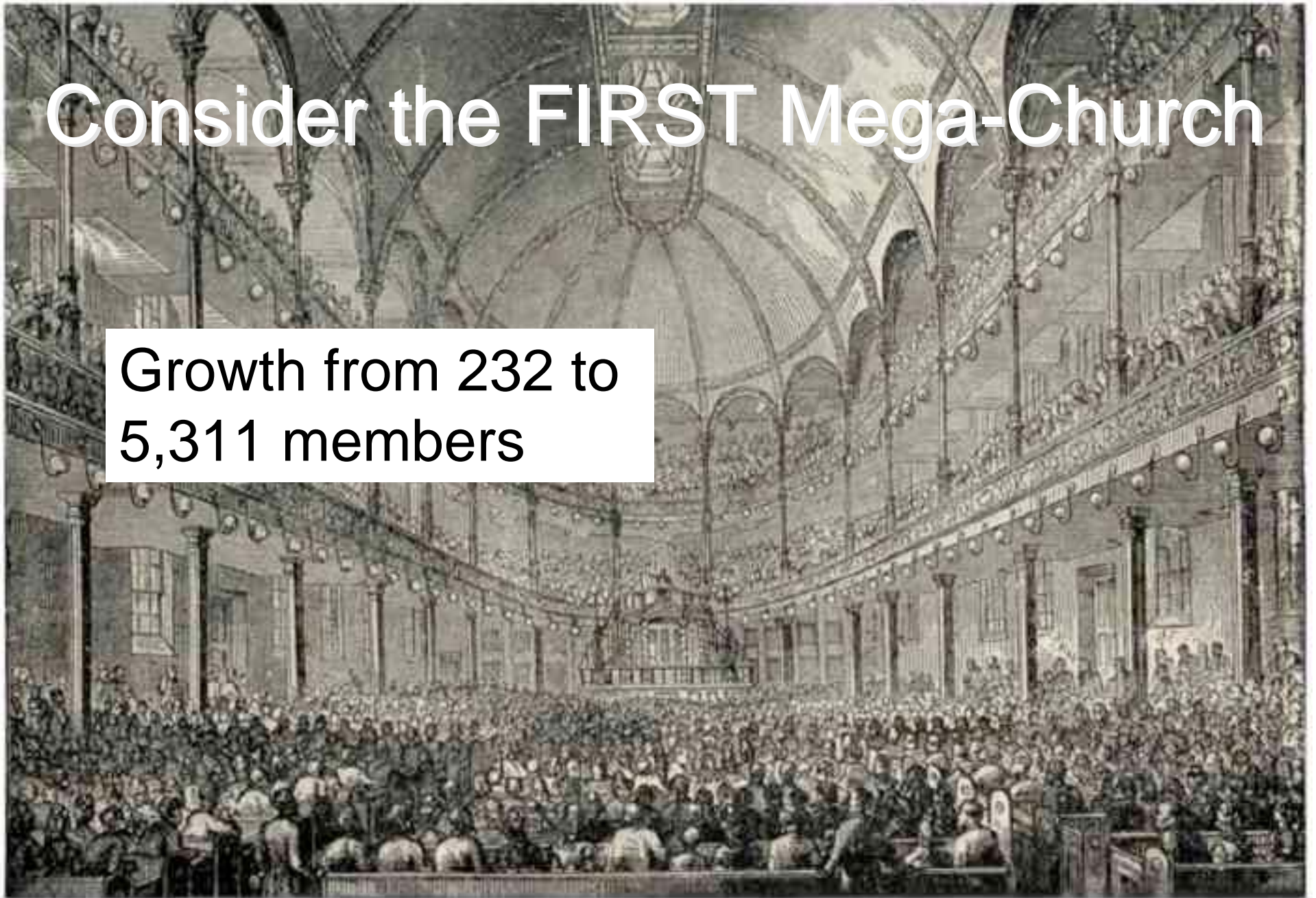

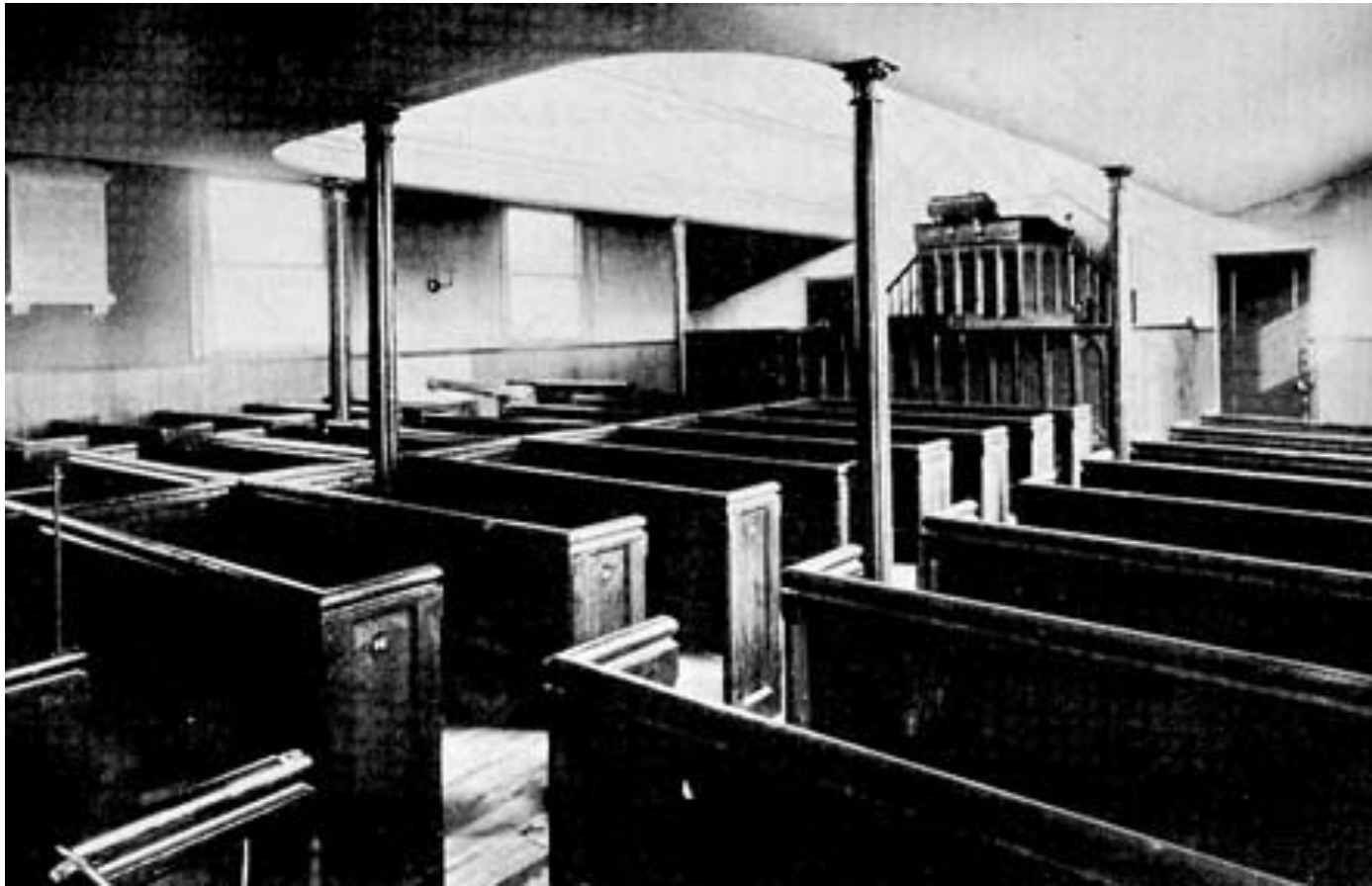

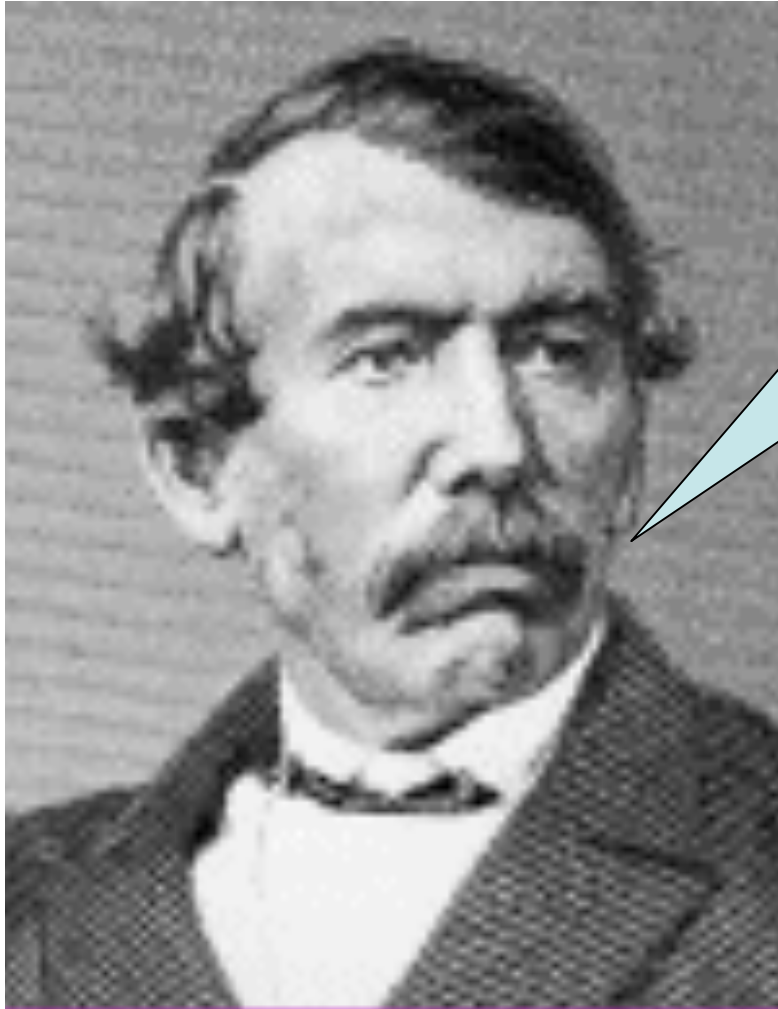


INTERIOR VIEW OF THE METROPOLITAN TABERNACLE.

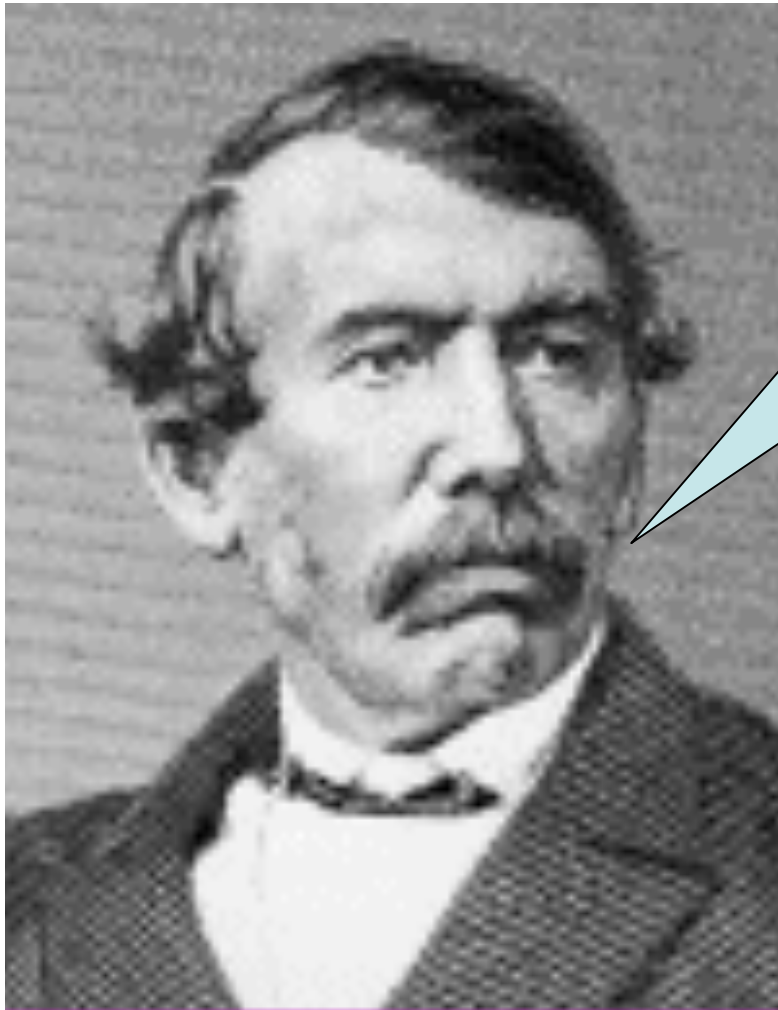
