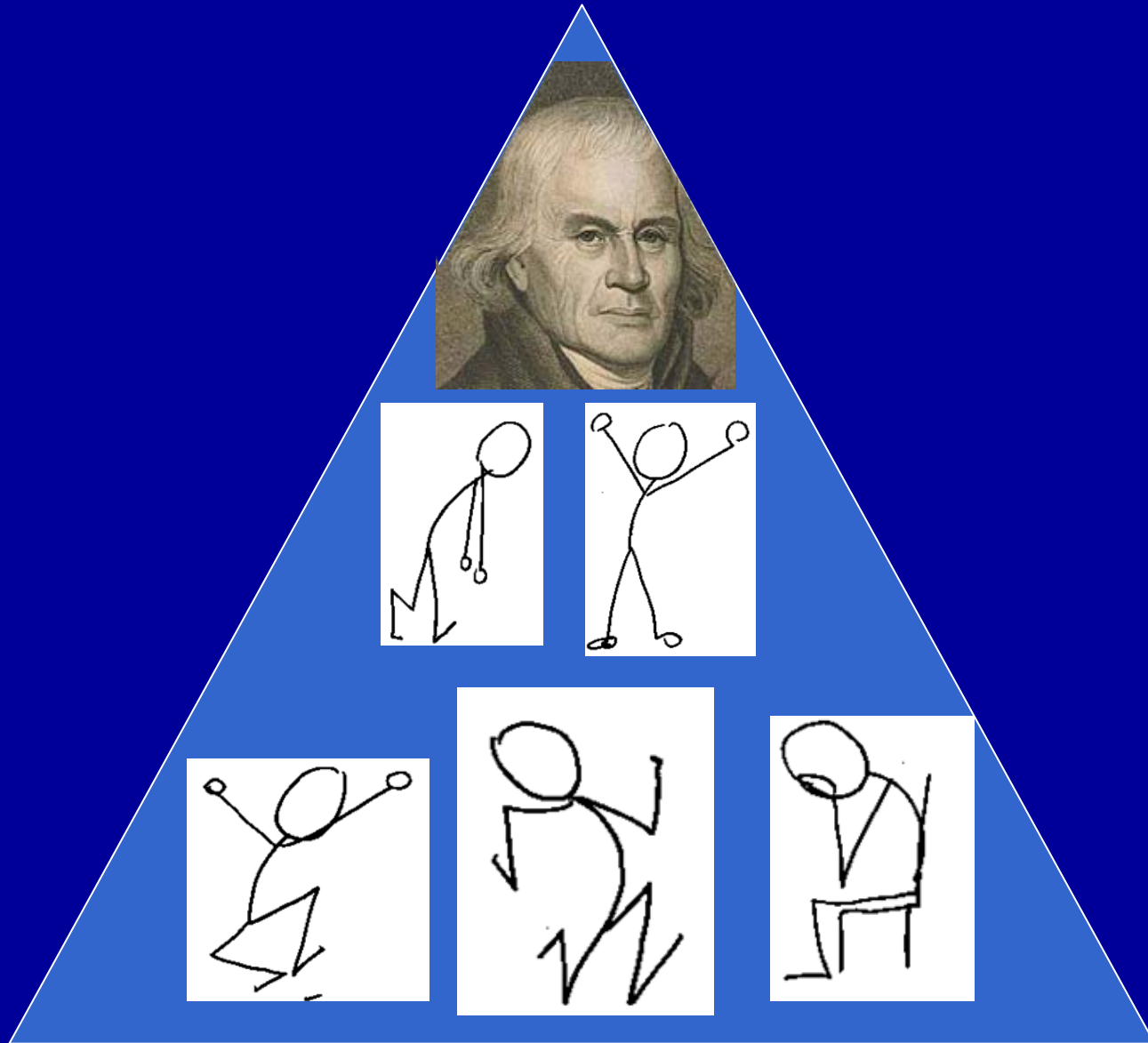
Pyramid of Sinners



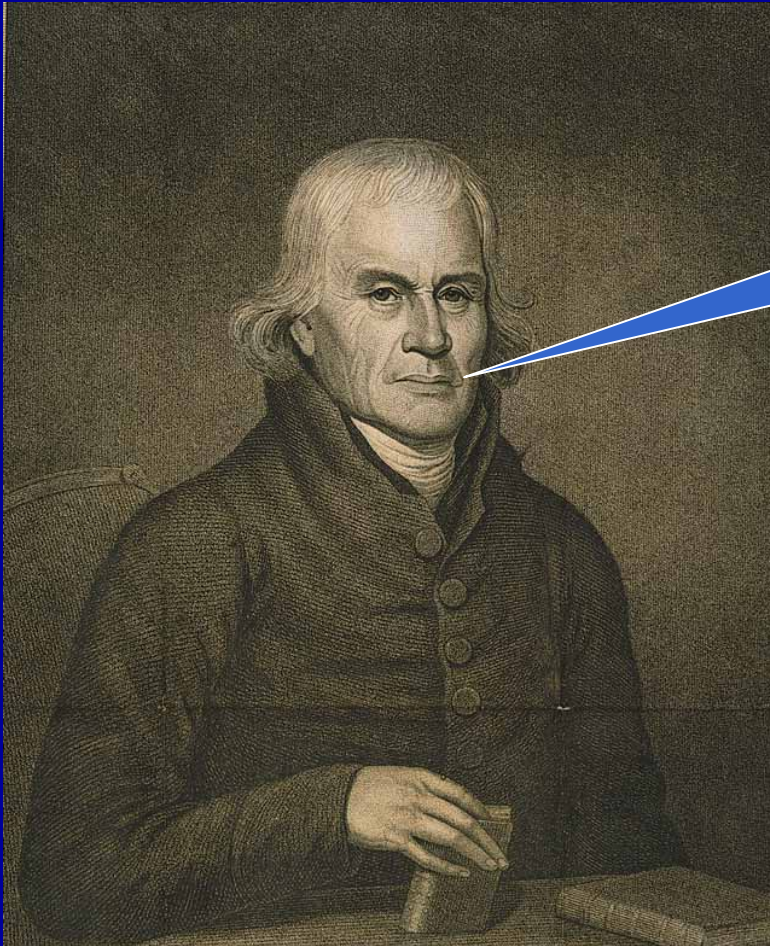
