And he asked them how much property they had. And both of them answered that they had a piece of land which contained only 39 acres, and from which they raised their taxes and supported themselves by their own labor.

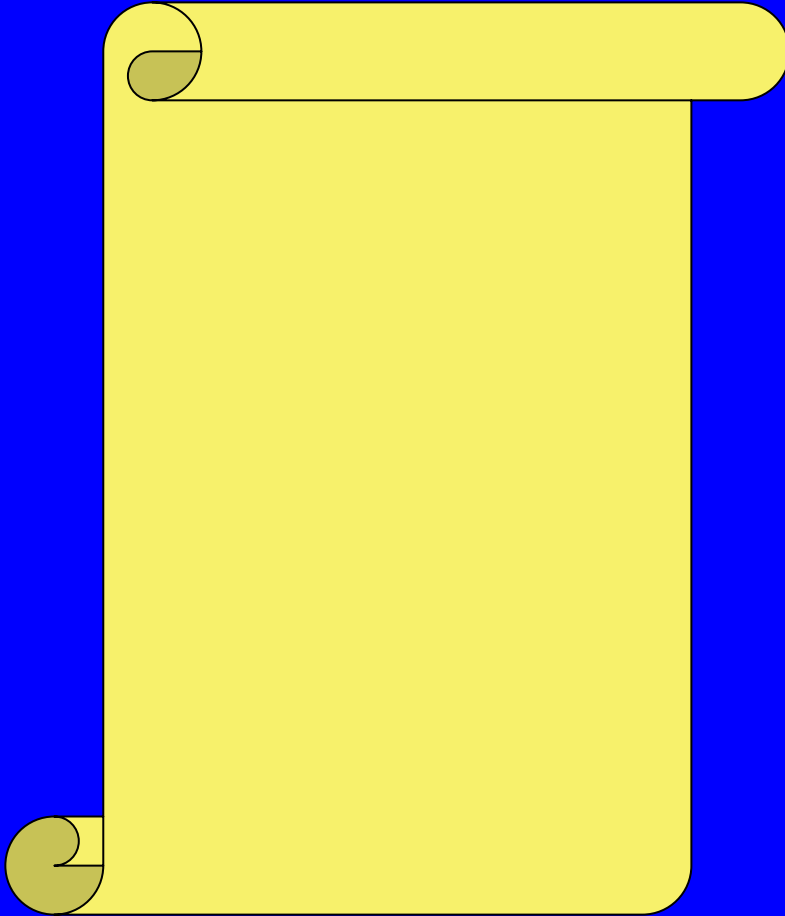
