This permanent sanctification comes about through the “baptism of the Holy Spirit”

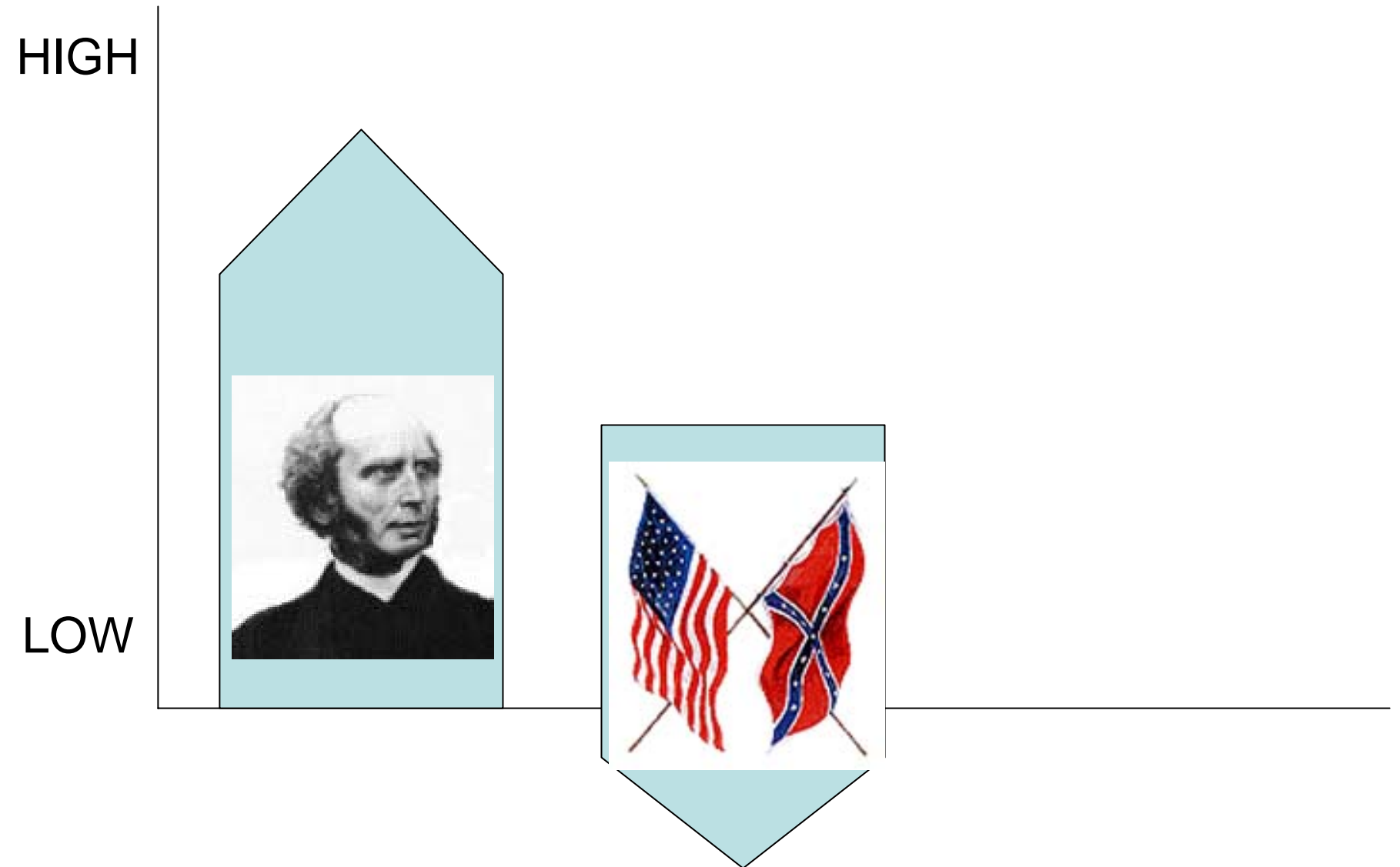
