


Paul becomes the central focus.

used to eat with the Gentiles



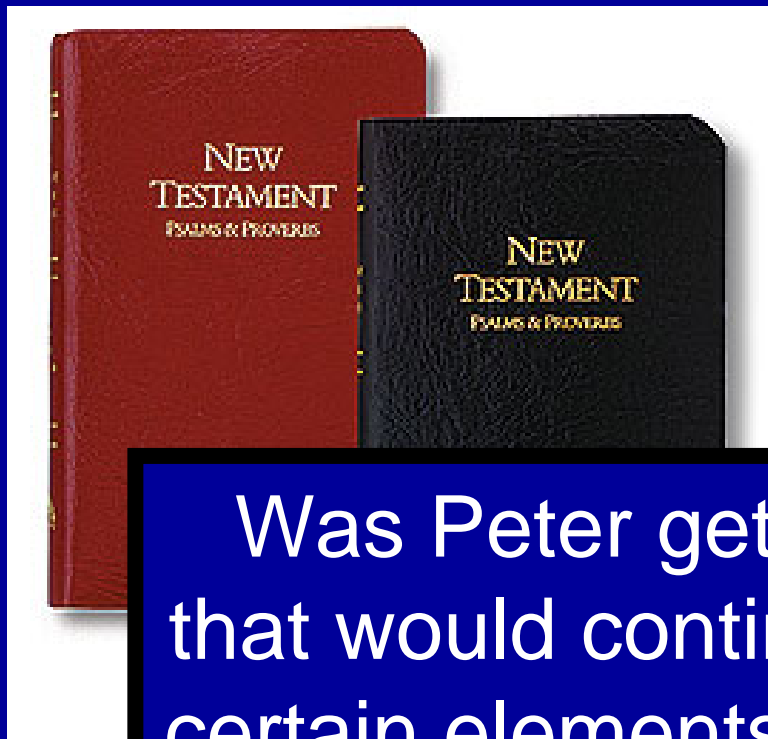

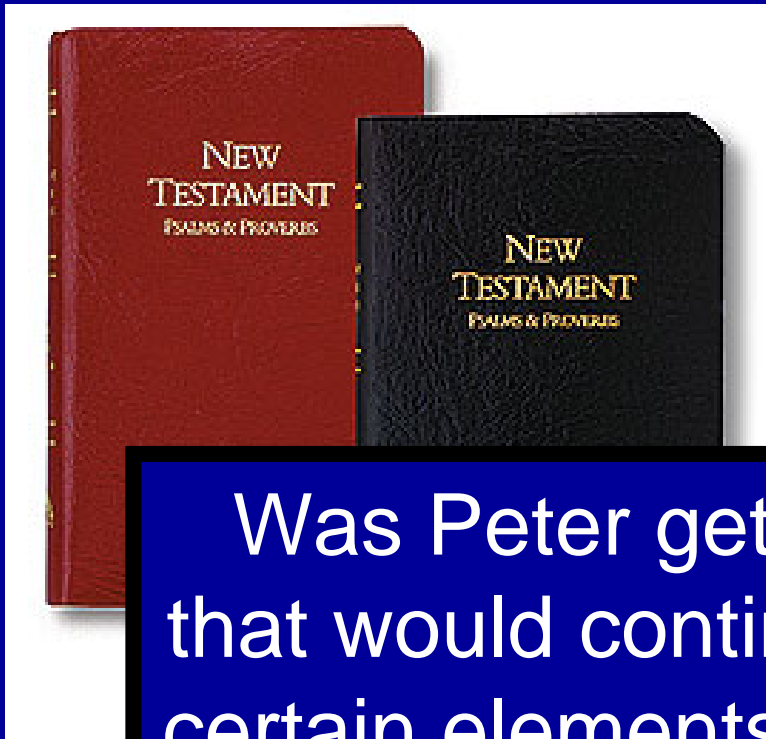
