The presbytery was going to suspend Stone and 4 others




The new Presbytery lasted only 9 months

From here we shall simply be called "Christians"




Three years later, Stone is immersed (1807)



By the 1830's there are 16,000 "Christians" in Kentucky, Tennessee. Alabama and Ohio


