- E/ is singular; Elohim is plural in form yet singular in meaning.

Adonai = Lord

"Lord" in sense of Title or position.

YHWH

- A personal name. A reference to God in a personal sense.
- Ex. 3:14-15
- "I am" or "I will be"
- John 6:54-59
- \blacksquare Yhwh = Yaweh = Lord

 - e, o, a (from Adonai)
 - Jehovah
