BACKGROUND

- Genesis ("Gen.") is the first book in the Old Testament.
- The book gives historical accounts of God and man from creation up to Joseph's death in Egypt (around 1650 B.C.).
- The first two chapters contain an account of God's creation of Adam, Eve and the garden of Eden.
