**JEREMIAH**

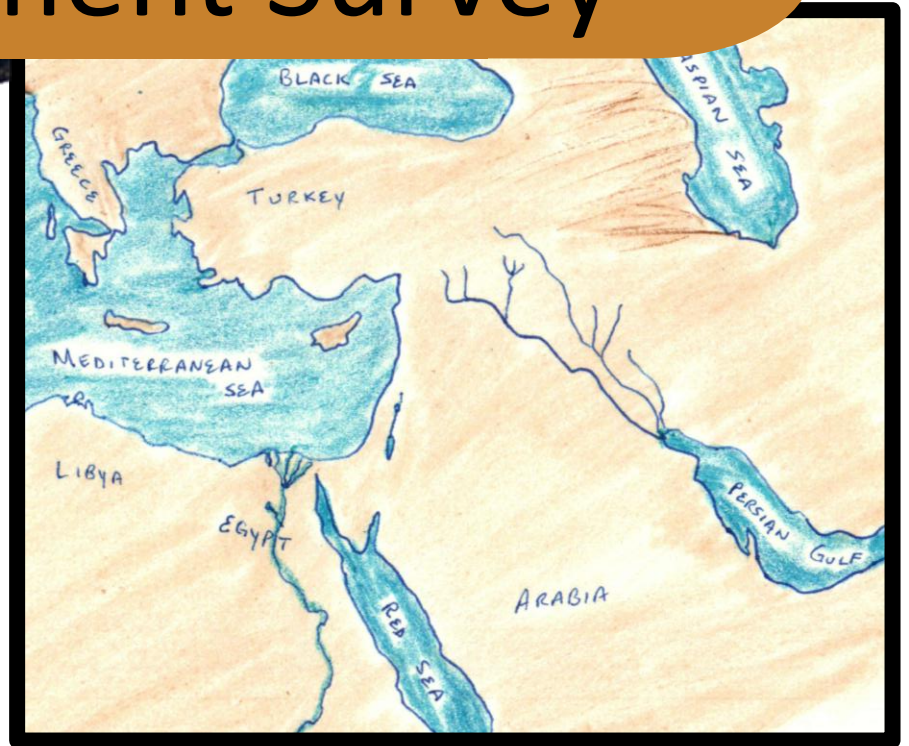
