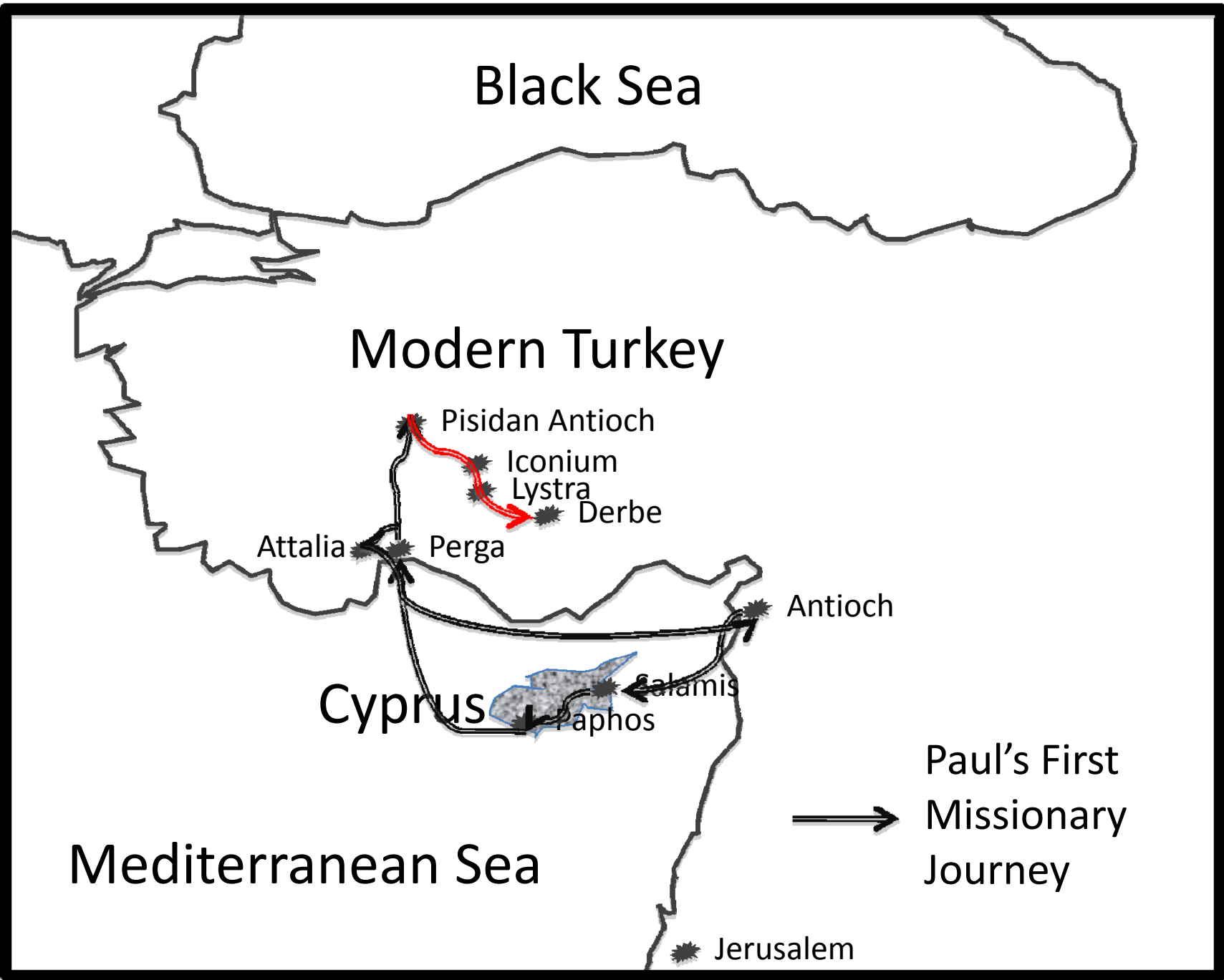


Garland is laid as a sacrifice
