







"They exchanged the glory of the immortal God for images resembling mortal man and birds and animals...






"Because of your hard and impenitent heart you are storing up wrath for yourself on the day of wrath when God's righteous judgment will be revealed"

Wrath is the natural consequence of sin and disobedience




If you stick your hand in fire, you will get burned


