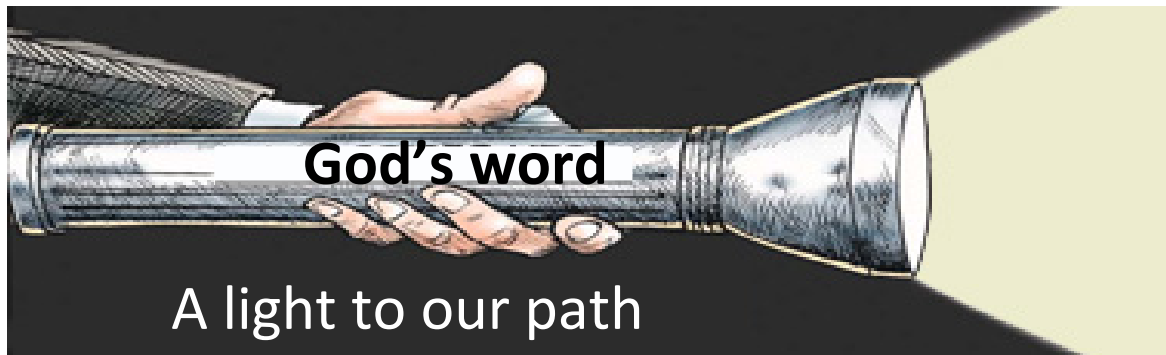
A light to our path

Points for Home

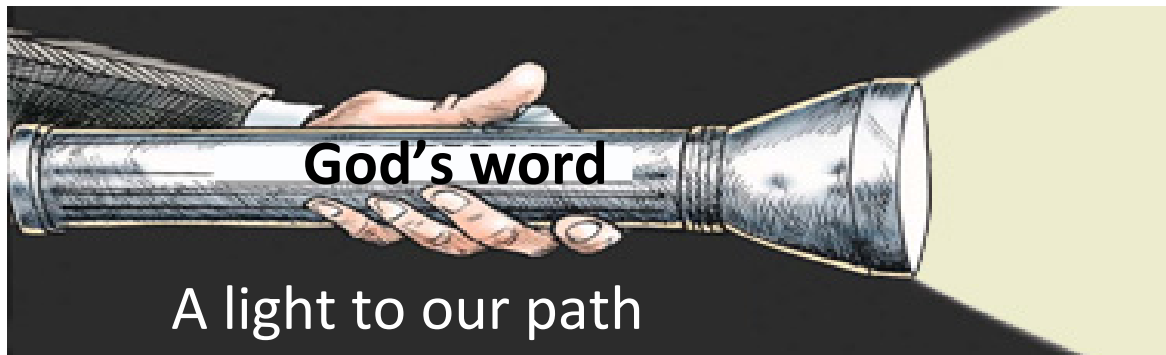


"Christ redeemed us" (Gal. 3:13)
